EDITORS TO MEET

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--(BP)--Annual mid-winter meeting of Southern Baptist editors will be held at Biloxi, Miss., on the gulf coast, February 12-13, Dr. O. W. Taylor of Nashville, association president, announced.

The program will feature discussions by three journalism professors from Baptist colleges, which men have made a three-months study of publications represented in membership of the association. They are Prof. E. E. Folk of Wake Forest College, North Carolina; Prof. Frank E. Burkhalter of Baylor University, Texas; and Prof. J. R. Scales of Oklahoma Baptist University. They will discuss, respectively, the mechanics, the means, and the message.

MISSISSIPPI GOES ALL-OUT FOR RELIEF

JACKSON, Miss.--(BP)--"Every Family Clothe a Family Day" was observed in Mississippi Baptist churches Sunday, January 11, in a state-wide appeal for donations to European relief.

Dr. D. A. (Schotchie) McCall, state executive secretary of Mississippi Baptists, estimated that a complete change of clothes weighs five pounds and set that as a goal for every member of Baptist families. Thus, a family of four was asked to contribute 20 pounds of clothing, bedding, or shoes.

The contributions were sent direct from the churches to the Southern Baptist relief center at New Orleans for reshipment to Baptist distribution points in Europe and Japan.
