Many requests have come from pastors and church members over the SBC requesting information on what they could do. The Home Mission Board, from its relief funds, has already sent \$5,000 to the Baptist Office in Jackson, Mississippi, to assist in meeting urgent emergency needs.

Dr. Douglas Hudgins, Mississippi Baptist Executive Secretary, has said the conservative estimate of uninsured losses to churches and parsonages, is close to \$1,000,000. Any funds for assistance should be sent to the Baptist Building in Jackson, Mississippi, marked for Hurricane Relief.
