## SBC DESIGNATED GIFTS INCREASE ALMOST HALF

NASHVILLE, Tenn.--(BP)--Total gifts to Southern Baptist Convention causes passed the three and one-quarter million mark late in February. Southern Baptists contributed \$3,284,113 to all Southern Baptist Convention causes the first two months of this year. This is 31.4 per cent or \$785,424.26 ahead of last year's \$2,498,688 for the same period. Most of this increase is accounted for in designated offerings up 45.7 per cent or \$627,823, from \$1,375,009 in 1950 to \$2,002,832 in 1951. This covers most of the Lottie Moon Christmas offering for missions.

The Cooperative Program also increased from \$1,123,679 in 1950 to \$1,281,280 in 1951, 14 per cent or \$157,600 for the two-month period. The announcement was made by Dr. Duke K. McCall, treasurer of the Southern Baptist Convention and Executive Secretary of the Executive Committee.
