Allison New Assistant
Kansas State Secretary

WICHITA, Kans.--(BP)--Paul Allison, pastor of Calvary Baptist Church, Columbia, Mo., will be assistant executive secretary of the Kansas Convention of Southern Baptists.

He moves to Wichita Feb. 24. The Kansas Convention board elected him at its quarterly meeting recently. Allison is the first assistant executive secretary to be elected in Kansas.

He will work in the fields of stewardship, missions, and promotion. A native Missourian, Allison attended Central Baptist Seminary, Kansas City, Kans.

The Kansas board, at the same meeting, began considering a plan to support its new church loan association. The church loan association guarantees up to 25 per cent of a church's building bonds to aid church extension.

At present, the convention has no specific budget funds set apart as security in case of a default. If the board approves a plan to secure the portion of the bonds it guarantees, an item will be included in the 1959 convention budget.

The board also called a part-time director of Baptist student work at Kansas State University, Manhattan. He is Lynn Stewart, a graduate of Southwestern Baptist Seminary.

Form Committee Of 100
For Houston College

HOUSTON--(BP)--A committee of 100 Baptist laymen has been formed to buy a plot of land on which a new \$1½ million Baptist junior college will be built.

Rex G. Baker, Houston attorney, was named chairman of the project after the site was approved by the Union Baptist Association.

The 380-acre tract is located in Sharpstown, a suburb of Houston. The purchase price is reported to be about \$2000 an acre.

Ross E. Dillon, executive secretary of Union Association, said a financial campaign to raise \$1½ million for endowment and another \$1½ million for construction of the school would be launched before the end of 1959.

Occupancy of the school is planned for September, 1961.
